# Have You Done Enough To Secure Your Eternal Future?

Have you ever tried to secure your eternal future? If you have, you would have discovered that it is futile to even try.

Of all the things that man can either acquire or conquer, eternity is not one of them. We cannot buy our way out of eternal condemnation in hell because of sin, or into eternal justification in heaven.

*(for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God - Romans 3:23).*

## Is There Such A Thing As Eternity?

It is possible that you've been advised that there is no such thing as eternity. Perhaps you have come to believe it yourself. But think about it for a moment; what if you are wrong? What if you die and wake up to the reality that life does not really end in our current physical reality? What if there is life after death? What do you think will happen?

*(And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment. So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation - Hebrews 9:27-28)*



## The Reality Of Heaven And Hell

Jesus has made provision of atonement for our sin. Through Him, grace is obtained and in the absence of Him, condemnation is proclaimed unto eternal judgment. Heaven and hell are real and we must secure our eternal future in heaven - not hell. This, however, is only possible through Jesus Christ and it is important that you do it without delay.

*(Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me - John 14:6)*

## How Can You Be Saved?

... Again He designates a certain day, saying in David, "Today," after such a long time, as it has been said: "Today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts:" (Hebrews:4:7)

Certainly not by your own works or physical abilities (... *a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ - Galatians 2:16).*

My sin and your sin had been paid for, in full *(But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us - Romans 5:8).* All you have to do is Repent; Renounce your sin and sinful ways; Confess and; Ask Christ to cleanse, make you righteous and free from the condemnation of sin.
